Owner of the the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the *Dog Show Rules*, AKC policy or the Standard for the Breed. Get must be entered in one of the regular classes at this show.

**Brood Bitch Class** – Same as stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class** – For two (2) dogs of the same breed and which must have the same ownership. All Braces must be entered in the Brace Class competition only or as an additional entry. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

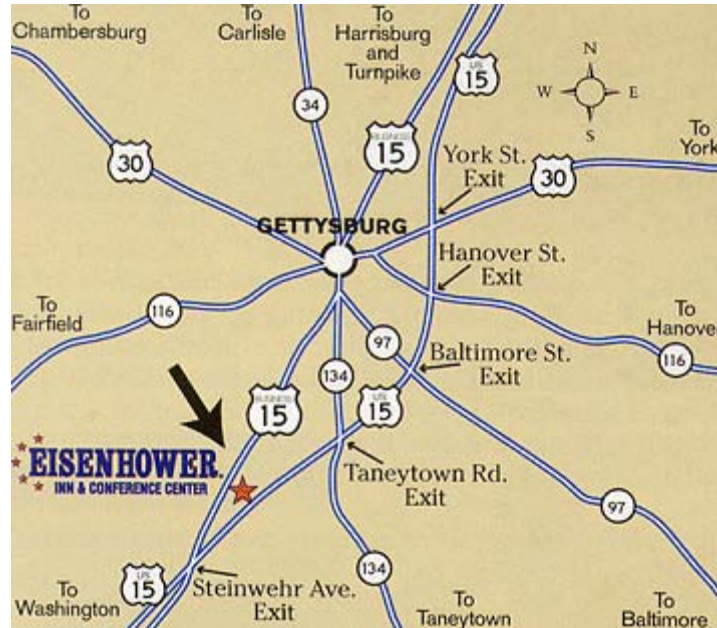
