The 2020 GSCA National Championships and Field Trial will be held at Bechtel Ranch, near Eureka, Kansas November 2-7, 2020. The GSCA National Championship and National Amateur Championships qualify as “Grand Stakes” (60 mins.). To be eligible to earn “Grand” points, a dog must have already been awarded its FC title (to earn points toward the GFC title), or its AFC title (to earn points toward the GAFC title).

Dogs that have not earned their FC or AFC title may enter Grand Limited stakes. Points earned by these dogs will be credited toward their FC or AFC title. Points will not be split between FC/AFC titles and GFC/GAFC titles.

AKC approved tracking collars permitted in all stakes. Horseback handling allowed in Open Gun Dog stake. No firing of blank pistols in the Puppy stake. This event is being run under the Unlimited Trial format.

ADDITIONAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entries in all stakes must include the dog’s AKC issued DNA Identification Number.

Championship and Amateur Championship: Limited to dogs that have earned an AKC Field Champion or Amateur Field Champion title; or have placed 1st in an AKC Gun Dog or All Age stake with 4 or more starters; or have placed 2nd-4th in an AKC Gun Dog or All Age stake with 8 or more starters.

Bitches in season may compete in the Grand National Championship and the Grand National Amateur Championship and Walking Open Gun Dog stakes only. There will be a re-brace on the grounds if needed.

Open Puppy: Open to dogs that are at least 6 months and less than 15 months of age as of Nov. 2, 2020

Open Derby: Open to dogs that are at least 6 months and less than 24 months of age as of Nov. 2, 2020

Open Gun Dog: Open to dogs that are at least 6 months of age as of Nov. 2, 2020

Scratch Policy: *Per AKC Field Trial Rules and Standard of Procedure for Pointing Breeds, entry fees will be refunded only for dogs that have injury, illness or are deceased prior to running in those stakes. The Field Trial Committee may require an appropriate veterinarian’s certificate as a condition precedent to any refunds.*

DIRECTIONS

5.5 miles West and 6 miles south (947 G Road) Eureka, Kansas
(GPS Coordinates: 37.744454 - 96.422539) Go west out of Eureka on Highway
54 for 5 miles, turn south on J Road for approx. 5 miles,
follow the jogs, turn right (west) 2 miles. Signs will be posted.

COURSES AND BIRDS

All stakes are single course without bird field. The Grand National
Championship, Grand National Amateur Championship, the Open Derby
and the Open Puppy shall be held on a different course than the Open
Gun Dog. Bobwhite Quail and/or Chukar will be released in all stakes, except
Open Puppy. Other species of upland game birds may be encountered on course.

PRIZES

Specially created trophies and prize packages awarded to all placed dogs in both
Championships. Trophies to winners in all stakes; Rosettes to placed dogs in all
stakes.

Pam Backman National Amateur Championship Trophy to the winner of the
National Amateur Championship stake. Trophy to be in the possession of the
winner until the conclusion of the 2021 National Amateur Championship. Upon
return of the trophy, a replica will be presented for permanent possession by the
winner.

Thanks to a contribution by long-time Gordon Setter enthusiast James Hustace,
the beautiful hand-carved Gordon Setter National Champion Trophy will be
awarded and will be in the possession of the winner until 2021.

VETERAN'S STAKE (Open To All Breeds)

The 10th annual "Running of the Veterans," a very special tribute stake for our
beloved senior dogs will be held during the 2020 NFT. At a time to be an-
nounced, all are encouraged to gather on the hills just east of the trial grounds
for the "Running of the Veterans!" This special stake will not be an "official"
event. It is intended for fun and as a way to let our senior dogs have their mo-
ment in the field. Dogs may be handled on foot or horseback, and run time
will be adjusted to accommodate both senior dogs and handlers. The stake will
be open to any breed of dog who is at least 8 years of age, or no longer in field
competition. The entry fee will be \$20, and there will be prizes for all dogs
entered. Nancy and the late George Grams sponsor this special event.

hoses to run continuously. Horses MUST be staked out. There are no
stabling facilities. Please use the trash receptacles and bags provided
and regularly clean up after your animals. Manure may be conveniently
shoveled into piles easily accessible to a skid loader. The septic dump
station will be clearly marked.
